BLUE MOUNTAIN GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB 6 PACK GREEN FEE TICKET PROGRAM

The Marketing Committee and the Board of Directors are pleased to announce the continuation of our “6 Pack” green fee program this season designed to enable members to bring guests at a reduced green fee rate!

Members may purchase a “6 Pack” of tickets at the same price as last year of \$250 plus tax!

- Members may purchase as many 6 Pack tickets as they wish.
- 6 Pack Tickets will be sold in the Pro Shop from Open House Weekend to through to June 15/10.
- Tickets must be used by October 31/10.
- Tickets may be used 7 days a week as per our Tee Time Policy.
- The member must be playing with the guest to use the ticket.
- A guest may participate in the 6 Pack program a maximum of 4 times through the season. (A guest may play at the Club more than 4 times during the season subject to regular green fee rates.)
- When submitting a 6 pack ticket, the guest must fill out the information required on the back of the ticket.

The 6 Pack program is an excellent opportunity to bring guests to the Club at a reduced rate this season!

BLUE MOUNTAIN GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB RESPONSIBLE ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION

In 2009, the Board of Directors reviewed our Food and Beverage procedures and worked with the Caterer and management to establish policies designed to confirm the responsible consumption of alcohol on Club property.

Once again this year, as required under the liquor licence at the Club, all servers are “Smart Serve” trained and must conduct the service of alcohol as per “Smart Serve” requirements. This means that a server is required to stop serving alcohol to a person due to the appearance of intoxication. The server’s decision is fully supported by the Board of Directors.

As approved by the Board, the server is to report each “discontinuance” to their supervisor and record the incident on a Club “Intoxication Report” which is to be forwarded to the General Manager. Please note that each instance requiring an Intoxication Report may be reviewed by the Disciplinary Committee which may result in disciplinary action.

It is important that each member conduct themselves in a responsible manner when consuming alcohol. In the event that you reach a level which may impair your ability to drive, you are required to arrange for alternative means of leaving the Club either by receiving a ride from a friend or through our “Courtesy Cab” program. If you require a cab due to the consumption of alcohol, please inform a member of our Food and Beverage Staff who will be pleased to arrange for taxi service to your home courtesy of the Club.

Through these steps, the Board believes that the Club will always provide an atmosphere of enjoyment while adhering to responsible consumption practices.
