BASIC RULES FOR BLUE

- LOST BALL AND OUT OF BOUNDS ARE RELATED
- WHEN IS A BALL YOU CANNOT FIND NOT A “*LOST BALL*”
- THERE ARE NO “*UNPLAYABLE*” BALLS IN A WATER HAZARD
- YELLOW MEANS **BEHIND**, RED MEANS **BESIDE**
- *IMPEDIMENTS* ARE NATURAL, *OBSTRUCTIONS* ARE MAN-MADE
